All students will be in person for learning  
for the 2021-2022 school year.

## SCREENING MEASURES AT HOME

A student or employee should stay home from school or work if the individual exhibits a fever of 100.4 F or greater and/or one or more of the following symptoms: Persistent/ Productive Cough - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing - Chills - Repeated shaking with chills - Muscle pain - Headache - Sore throat - New loss of taste or smell - Vomiting - Nausea.

## COVID HOME QUARANTINE

### Test Positive for COVID-19:

Everyone regardless of vaccination status, shall stay home for 5 days. If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return. However, you must wear a mask around others for days 6-10.

### Maximum Immunity:

#### Student:

- 2 doses of Pfizer/Moderna vaccine
- Booster
- Infection within 90 days-proof must be provided

#### Adult:

- 2 doses of Pfizer/Moderna vaccine within 6 months
- 1 dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine within 2 months
- Booster
- Infection within 90 days proof must be provided

### Exposure & Maximum Immunity:

#### If exposed and have Maximum Immunity:

You do not need to quarantine, but you must wear a mask around others for 10 days.

#### If exposed and do not have Maximum Immunity:

You must stay home for 5 days from the date of exposure, then you can return to school or work, but you must wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOL



**MASKS** – Masks will be optional for the 2021-2022 school year. In general, masks are recommended but will not be required for staff or students. In specific situations, where there has been a positive COVID case, they may be times where masks will be required for students or staff in order to help mitigate the viral spread. HCCSC does not anticipate this being a regular occurrence.



**TRANSPORTATION** – Students are recommended to wear face masks while on the bus. There will be assigned seating and siblings will be seated together whenever possible. Students will have one pick-up and one drop-off location.



**DIVIDED CLINIC LOCATIONS** – There will be an area for students displaying symptoms who are waiting to be picked up and another area for medication distribution, etc.



**HAND WASHING** – Hand washing will be required throughout the day. Additional hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.



**WATER BOTTLES** – Personal water bottles are recommended.



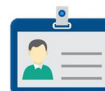
**SEATING CHARTS** – Seating charts will be required on buses, in classrooms, and in the cafeteria. Siblings will be seated together on buses.



**STAY HOME IF SICK** – Families must screen their children and keep them home if ill. Sick children will be directed immediately upon arrival to the clinic assistant who will require him/her to be picked up if exhibiting symptoms.



**LUNCH**—NO OUTSIDE VISITORS WILL BE PERMITTED TO EAT MEALS WITH STUDENTS AT THIS TIME.



**VISITORS / VOLUNTEERS** – Schools will have traditional activities physically open to parents, guardians, and the community. All visitors will perform a self-check for COVID-19 symptoms prior to entering buildings.

## CHANGES TO THE CLASSROOM AND SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

### BACK TO SCHOOL

- All open houses, back-to-school nights, and parent-teacher conferences will be in-person.
- All clubs, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities will return to in-person meetings.
- Staff and students will continue to maintain social distancing when practical.

### CLASSROOM

- Normal school routines will be followed as much as possible.
- Recess, art, music, and physical education classes will resume as normal.
- Field trips and convocations will be allowed this school year.
- Student seating will be practical in maximizing space between and among individuals will continue to be implemented.

### ENHANCED CLEANING PROTOCOLS

- Safe, effective cleaning products used on schedule throughout the day in all high-touch areas in the school and the classroom.
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected on the bus at the end of each route.
- Intense cleaning nightly.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Students who have had COVID-19 within the last 90 days, and have proof of a positive test, will not need to quarantine if exposed. Parents may administer a home COVID-19 test to document a positive result for their student and complete the HCCSC Home COVID-19 Test Verification Form located on the corporation web page under Re-entry Plans.
- HCCSC will eliminate attendance incentives for students for the 2021—2022 school year.
- The federal government will continue to provide free school meals for all students K-12 during the 21-22 school year.
